The Phoenix Chapter 113 has selected Arizona Burn Foundation Inc. and it's programs as our only charity for this event.

The Arizona Burn Foundation Inc. is dedicated to assisting victims and their families in becoming burn survivors through rehabilitation, treatment and research; the reduction of death and injury from burns and fire through prevention education, and serving as an advocacy partner for the prevention of trauma associated with injuries.

The Foundation provides many rehabilitative and supportive programs including the Arizona Children's Burn Camp (Camp Courage), school re-entry initiatives, adult and teen support groups, counseling, tutoring for youth burn survivors and cultural and educational outings. The Foundation also offers an emergency shelter, "Forever Courage House" which is available for family members while a loved one is hospitalized at the Arizona Burn Center. Camp Courage is a weeklong event held in the cool pines near Prescott that helps children with serious burn injuries adjust to an atmosphere predicated upon comfort and friendship. Children have the opportunity to be himself or herself in groups that are non-judgmental, outgoing and friendly; counselors ensure the experience will last a lifetime.

Unlike other motorcycle rides that take place throughout the year where hundreds or even thousands of riders participate The Arizona Children's Burn Camp Run is limited in size. The physical size of the camp does not provide enough space for a large event. Coupled with the concept that we are truly guests of the campers for a very short period of time we do not want to overshadow their special week in paradise. Therefore, we must rely on your generous contributions to raise the necessary money to keep this altruistic organization moving forward.
